



## The 1 October something new happens regarding abnormal transport permits...

From 1 October 2021 the issuing of abnormal transport permits will be transferred from the Police to the Danish Road Directorate.

From then on, all applications for the Danish Road Directorate must be submitted via [virk.dk](https://virk.dk) at: [rov.vd.dk/st](https://rov.vd.dk/st)

## Where can I obtain further information?

On the Danish Road Directorate's homepage, information about abnormal transport permits will be issued during September:

Application must be made via an electronic application form, where most of the particulars though are identical to those of the present solution. It will not be possible to apply for abnormal transport permits via the link until 1 October 2021. However, we expect the website to open at the end of September allowing you to see a number of features of the system.

## You need to use NemID...

Application for abnormal transport permit via [virk.dk](https://virk.dk) requires that you log in using your NemID employee signature. If you do not already have a NemID employee signature, you can order one via the link below, where relevant information can also be found as well as help with NemID employee signature.

Please note that when ordering NemID employee signature the processing will take some time, and we therefore recommend that you make your order in good time before 1 October.

## Will permits issued prior to 1 October still remain in force?

If you have applied to the Police, but have not yet received your permit by 1 October, your application will be processed by the Danish Road Directorate. In that case you do not need to make a new application.

If you have applied and received a permit from the Police before 1 October that will remain in force beyond this date, your permit will continue to be in force.

## Foreign applicants
